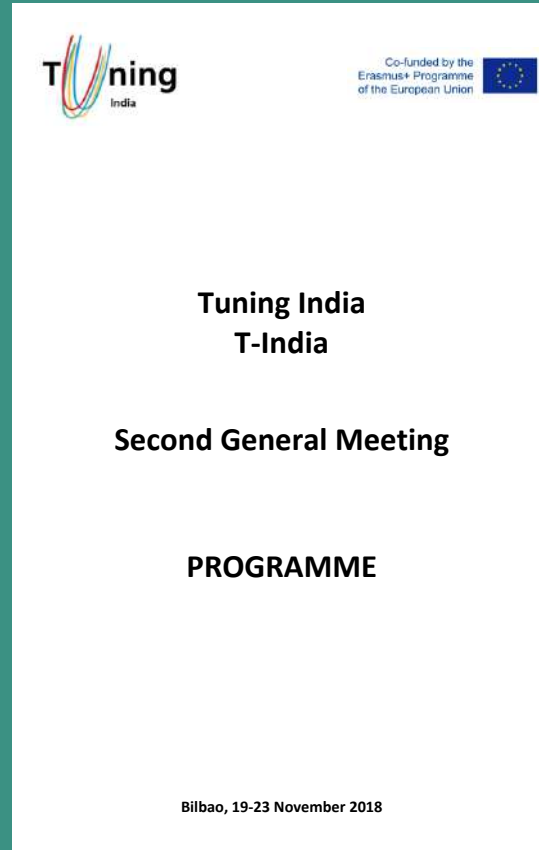

Meta-Profiles for ICT, Medicine, Law and Teacher Education

Subject Area Groups not only agree on the lists of components that identify the core and the level of diversification but also take the next necessary step of classifying the findings and creating a structure that communicates how they understand the relationship of the components to each other. These are called meta-profiles and represent the structure and combination of competences that give identity to a subject area. A meta-profile is a mental construct that categorizes competences into major recognized components and illustrates their interrelationship.
